- The School Bus Coordinator (speaks English and Hungarian) is available 24/7 on mobile phone.
- Experienced drivers with clean driving records.

- Children are picked up at their homes and are transported to the kindergarten.
- In the afternoons we take them home or alternatively to any other destination (grandparents, sports activity, music lesson, etc.). We provide the same drivers all year round.

Our vehicles

Seat of 7-20 children and are equipped with seatbelts.
Air-conditioning and GPS are installed in each bus, so the coordinator can track them.

Payment

cash or bank transfer

Service operates with yearly passes. Parents have the option of paying for the whole school year or by term.

Use of the service is either both ways or mornings/afternoons only.

Refund is only given for a child who withdraws from attending the Kindergarten.

Fee per year (morning+afternoon)

District XII: 483.000Ft+VAT

District I., II. and V.: 507.150FT+VAT

(If parents wish to accompany their child at the beginning, they can take the bus for half price for four weeks.)

Registration fee: 20.000Ft+VAT

Pick up time:

In the mornings buses arrive to the kindergarten by 8:50 a.m.

How do children get into the kindergarten after getting off the bus?

Children are accompanied by the drivers, who help them take off their shoes and take them to their teachers and group in the kindergarten.

Departure time:

In the afternoons buses depart from the kindergarten between 3:30 p.m.-3.50 p.m.

How do children get to the afternoon buses and how do they find the right bus?

Children are accompanied to the buses by the kindergarten personnel, where the bus drivers help the children find the right bus.

Safety rules

- Only the driver may open and close the doors.
- Seatbelts must be worn at all times.
- No drinking or eating while on the bus.
- No throwing objects out of the windows.
- No leaning out of the windows.
- No littering, no damage to the vehicle.
- Dirty schoolbags must be kept off the seats.
- No toy weapons of any form on board.
- No swearing, shouting, or fighting will be tolerated.
